Safety Training Program



When you are faced with an issue related to environmental, safety and health, whether it be a surprise inspection, industrial accident or permitting question, your first call should be to **Printing Industries Alliance (PIA)**. PIA has offered “regulatory” services to its’ membership for over 10 years and, in conjunction with Printing Industries of America, provides a tremendous amount of expertise in assisting members.

A major portion of the services offered involve safety training. Participation in this **no-cost** training can help your employees work safer, reduce your exposure to Workers’ Compensation losses and help keep you out of trouble with OSHA, DEC and other regulatory agencies. Training topics, available FREE to members, include:

■ **OSHA 10 Hour General Industry Outreach for Printing Companies:** This program covers a variety of different topics including Introduction to OSHA, Walking and Working Surfaces, Fire Protection, Electrical, Flammable/Combustible Liquids, Machine Guarding, Material Handling and more. This program is available to be held at your facility at no charge and is also scheduled during the year in various cities in our territory.

■ **Ergonomics Training:** Ergonomics is not an OSHA standard so you can’t get cited, right? Wrong! An OSHA inspector witnessing an unsafe work practice can still cite your company even when an OSHA standard does not cover the work practice. Ergonomics contribute greatly to lost work time, and can have a very significant impact on the bottom line.

■ **Lift Truck Safety Training and Certification:** Lift truck accidents are almost always serious. OSHA mandates that all personnel operating lift trucks receive safety training and certification of their safe operating ability. Failure to do so can result in a significant fine for each untrained operator. PIA staff will conduct a comprehensive safety training program, followed

by a hands-on road test. Trainees who satisfy the training and road test requirements will receive National Safety Council certification.

■ **Hazardous Waste Management Training:** For many companies, depending on the volume of hazardous waste generated, employees who manage and/or handle hazardous waste are subject to mandatory annual training. PIA staff will conduct this training, on site, at your request.

■ **OSHA Mandated Training:** Training on OSHA mandated topics is available to be conducted at no charge, on any shift, at your facility. We can also custom prepare a training session for you if your company has a special need. Topics include:

- Hazard Communication
- Lockout/Tagout
- Emergency Action Plan/Fire Extinguisher
- Personal Protective Equipment

Other Topics include:

- Safe Lifting Techniques
- Workplace Violence Protection

WEBINAR TRAINING: PIA Safety Training is also available via webinar. OSHA compliance training can be performed for Emergency Evacuation/Fire Protection, Hazard Communication and Lockout/Tagout to your employees at your facility and broadcast it live from our Amherst office when it best fits your schedule.

Benefits are many. Far less costly to the association, but a far bigger advantage to the member. You need not bring large groups off the floor at any one time for long periods of time. Training can be scheduled when it fits well for the member. Emergency Evacuation and Fire Safety and Hazard Communication is also available in a recorded **Spanish webinar** presentation.

COST: **There will be no charge for the training** if conducted at your company (if training is conducted at an off-site location, there will be a nominal charge to cover expenses). There is a \$5.00 per trainee cost for forklift training to cover National Safety Council materials.

BEYOND TRAINING: Printing Industries Alliance provides consultation on safety-related topics with members on a regular basis.
